### INDOOR MDF WALL PROFILE

Our collection ensures optimum style and premium quality that will provide many years of valuable performance.

In addition, our products are designed for low maintenance, they are treated with a coating on the surface that helps to defend against minor scuffing.

We have done the hard work in the beginning to provide you a product that requires low maintenance but like everything it will still require some love and tender care.

Below are important but basic instructions on how to keep your profile looking new for years to come.

### Installation Pre-requisite

- ❖ Ensure that the profiles do not come into direct contact with heaters and air conditioners.
- ❖ The profiles must not be installed outdoor, in yards or alfresco, in areas that may come in contact with water or exposed to steam.

### Immediately following installation

- ❖ Gently remove all loose debris using a vacuum (soft head) or a soft bristled broom/brush.
- ❖ If any adhesive is used and is visible on the surface remove immediately.
- ❖ Clean the profiles with a microfiber cloth and warm water.
- ❖ Any spare material left over should be horizontally stored away for future replacement if required.

### Regular Care and Maintenance

- ❖ Clean the profile with warm water using a PH neutral detergent as strong cleaners can cause permanent damage to your profile.
- ❖ Do not use surface cleaners that contain chemical or abrasive cleaners as it may cause the profiles to become hazy and scratched.
- ❖ Do not use steel wool, scrubbers, and dry cloth to clean the profile as it may damage the surface.
- ❖ Ensure all furniture do not have direct contact with the profile, this will help prevent scratching, denting, and scuffing.
- ❖ Exposure to UV rays can cause fading and/or discolouration. Protect your profile from direct sunlight with curtains/blinds/tints or any type of blockers, to prevent discolouration/fading from the sun as warranty does not cover this.
- ❖ Due to the nature of the profiles, being made of MDF, exposure to high humidity or water can cause the product to swell.
